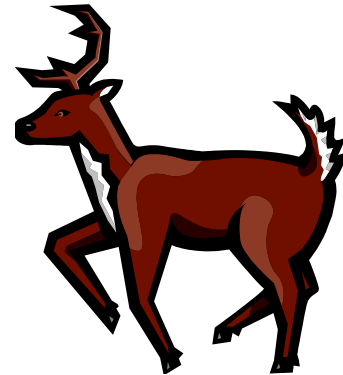
WILDERNESS ADVENTURE is all about.

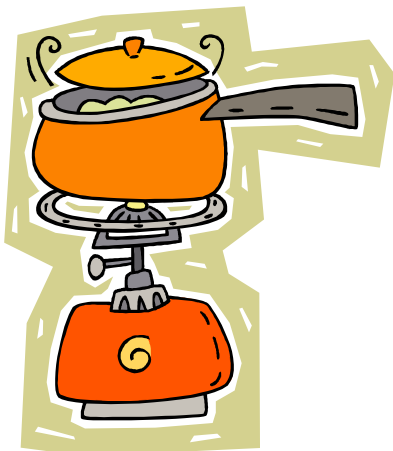
COST: Only \$80.00 per child per camp!

Things to Know

Clothing: For the most part, we recommend long pants but not jeans. Shorts expose us to more bugs, briars, and nettles, but the tradeoff may be worth it in hot weather. We insist on a hat of some sort. T-shirts are fine. We may see some cooler than normal days so bring a long sleeve T-shirt, a sweatshirt, or fleece for just in case. We’ll provide rain ponchos. Hiking boots are nice but not necessary. Sturdy sneakers are good but they will probably see water and mud. An extra pair of socks may be helpful for those days when we accidentally step ankle deep into the stream or mud. Sandals and open-toed footwear are forbidden.

Cameras: Highly recommended! The campers can trade photos, post them on our website, or even get them published in the Sun-Gazette. You’ll have to decide what kind of camera to send along. Obviously, we can’t guarantee its safety.

Website: We’re going to try to post photos on www.fsbweb.org.

Backpacks: No need to get fancy. A book bag or daypack will suffice. Just make sure the zippers work and that it has two shoulder straps. We have a few junior frame packs that the older bigger campers may want to try on for size.

Parent Participation: Parents are welcome to spend any and every day with us. We’d love for you to hike with us. The overnigher is especially designed for parents and siblings to join in. Be sure to complete the *Overnigher Reservation*. If you have a family tent that can be brought along, please let me know.

Food: We will provide snacks, meals, and drinks (mostly water) and water bottles. Eat a good breakfast every morning. **Please don’t bring chocolate, soft drinks, or sports drinks.**

Miscellaneous: Each camper will need to bring his/her own insect repellent and sunscreen. Throw in a few plastic grocery bags to keep extra clothes dry and clean, and for garbage, wets and dirties.
